- Reduced risk of lifestyle-related diseases

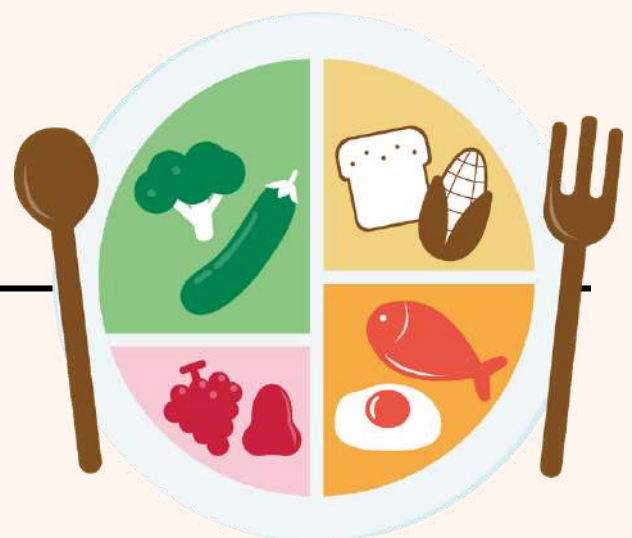
Students were also guided on cultivating healthy eating habits such as preferring whole foods, limiting processed and sugary items, staying adequately hydrated, and planning balanced meals.
